Small groups recommended for people who would like to improve their **spoken fluency** and enrich their **vocabulary**.

**Small groups** - a small group of between 4-8 people offers the safety to boost your confidence. The courses very much depend on your fellow students as you will be interacting together (not just with the teacher).

**Teacher** - I am an experienced native speaker who is continually trying to develop professionally as a teacher and learn from those around me. Don't expect to sit at the back and sleep in my lessons! On this course, I follow a 'materials light' approach. It means that YOU, the students are our main resource. The course will be tailored to you. Sometimes the group dynamic is fantastic and occasionally I have to work really hard to inspire, but I promise I will work hard and work you hard too!

**Levels** - I will give you a short interview to assess your level and suitability for the group I am creating. Choosing the right combination of people is essential so I will advise you if I think it would be better for you to wait for another group at your level.

**"But I don't know English grammar!"** - there is very little systematic grammar input on these short courses because the focus is on communication. Instead, you will be corrected when you make a mistake. If you expect a more thorough approach, choose a General English course instead!

**"I want to improve my vocabulary"** - the courses are designed thematically so you will boost your knowledge of general topics and will be able to hold a discussion in English.

**"I'm shy"** - this doesn't matter. My mission is to get you speaking! However, students in these groups should be willing to try and speak and contribute to discussions. You will not break down the language barrier unless you make an effort you join in - I can't help you unless you try! So get stuck in and [join a group today](#).
